



We have recently learned that three of our staff members at the Co-Op tested positive for Covid-19. Upon learning the result we moved quickly to contact the Arkansas Department of Health. We are following all recommended guidelines from public health authorities, including the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

Two staff members that tested positive last worked January 4th and 5th and it appears exposure occurred outside of the Co-Op. The staff members have not worked a shift since they were exposed. An additional staff member tested positive and last entered the back office area of the Co-Op January 18th. It appears exposure occurred outside of the Co-Op. Anyone who was within 6 feet of the individuals for more than 15 minutes in a 24 hour period will be informed of the contact for contact tracing purposes. The areas these staff worked are thoroughly sanitized on a daily basis with CDC recommended sanitization protocols. After rigorous cleaning the store continues to remain open for business.

Our Co-Op prides itself on its cleanliness and food safety standards, and we are taking multiple steps to best serve you, care for our staff, and be a responsible member of our community. We have implemented rigorous cleaning practices throughout our store, including more frequent cleanings of high-touch areas across our entire Co-Op.
